JOB OUTLINE: Work within an established Community Mental Health Team serving the Shoreham locality. Planned and urgent community-based assessments of patients referred by General Practitioners and CMHT members. Medical assessments and CPA review (with a team member) of patients. Liaison with crisis resolution team and care coordinators assessing patients referred urgently from A&E, DGH, criminal justice or psychiatric in-patient settings. Care coordination of a limited, supervised and short-term caseload. Work on inpatient acute wards, participation in mental health act work and tribunals.

Involvement is expected in service planning, educational work within general hospital and primary care settings, and the development of team protocols and guidelines.

On-call cover on Consultant rota for the Worthing/Southern Acute Mental Health unit.
